



MWOOL® LOW IMPACTS WERE CALCULATED WITH AN UNPRECEDENTED LIFE CYCLE ASSESSMENT

Our study, in collaboration with the prestigious Politecnico di Torino, develops an environmental analysis of recycled wool fibers through the Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) methodology. A parallel LCA is developed for virgin wool fibers too, in order to obtain a data-based comparison. Results show that recycled wool fibers have significantly lower environmental impacts than virgin fibers, even when the most unfavorable scenarios are considered.

MWool® fibers' impacts also received their Higg Materials Sustainability Index (Higg MSI) score, and MWool® yarns' impacts were also calculated and certified according to the EPD® Environmental Product Declaration scheme.



An EPD® is a certified Environmental Product Declaration, which trasparently reports environmental data over the life cycle of products in accordance with the international standard ISO 14025.

MWool® is available in more than 1000 colors, which are obtained without added chemicals and dyes through our Recype color creation process, just by mixing numerous and different shades of recycled wool fibers, developing actual 'recipes' of no-dye colors, which are archived and adapted to the kgs of yarns that need to be produced.

Thanks to this technique, in more than 80 years in the field of wool recycling, we have developed our **Infinity Color Collection**. An always-evolving archive of **more than 1000 no-dye colors** that we have carefully developed and preserved along the decades.
