## Performance Days dives into water stewardship

November's Performance Days hopes to help the industry preserve "one of our most - if not the most precious resource."

**MUNICH – The focus of this November's Performance Days in Munich will be on the industry's responsibility when it comes to water usage and pollution.**

**As such, the show's agenda will feature workshops and speakers from a broad spectrum of backgrounds, assessing the textile sector's current water impact and how all points of the supply chain can improve.**

Described by the event organisers as "one of our most - if not the most precious resource," water has been selected as the overarching theme of this season's Performance Days due to it being deemed a vital area for industry reform.

The three core aims of the event is the reduction of water consumption, to explore new methods to decrease water pollution and to discuss solutions to the issue of textile-derived microplastic pollution in water systems.

Speakers will include Sophie Mather from biov8tion, on the topic of *Re-Engineering Textile - Avoiding Microplastics*; and a session titled *Water - the Bigger Picture* delivered by senior researcher at Swerea IVF, Christina Jönsson.
